Promises, Promises, **Promises**

If ever you've spoken this threefold litany, it is likely because someone whom you had trusted, or at least wanted to trust, had broken a promise. And you likely know how you feel when someone breaks a promise to you: betrayed, angry, disappointed, devastated.



But if ever you have been on the receiving end of the litany, it is because you have broken a promise. And I would guess that it is equally likely that you know how you feel when you break a promise: ashamed, guilty, miserable, unlovable.

A few weeks ago, I stood in the front of our church while four youth made promises to me, to the church, and to God. And as I looked them each in the eye as they made that promise, I could detect nothing but sincerity there. And yet, there was a part of me that remembered what it was like to be 14 years old and making promises when I was confirmed. I remember what it was like to be 23 and making promises when I was married. Heck, for that matter, I know what it is like to be my current age, making a promise. What is a promise but an opportunity to prove our human limitations?

When's the last time you made a promise that you've broken? I promise to lose some weight. I promise to quit smoking. I promise to exercise more. I promise to attend church more. I promise to read through the Bible this year. I promise not to miss your concert this time. I promise to have just one drink. I promise I'll never look at another man. I promise I'll never look at another woman. I promise I'll never hit you again. I promise I'll stop looking at porn on the internet. I promise to be faithful to you until death parts us. I promise that I will have no other gods.

Promises, promises. Look at yourself honestly: if the promises you have made will be the measure upon which your eternal future is based, what will that eternal future look like? If you're anything like me, and knowing what I know about human nature you are, it doesn't look good, "for all sin and fall short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23).

In the end, thanks be to God, it is not the strength of the promises of those fourteen year olds, or the strength of your promises or the strength of my promises that will matter, but the strength of the promises of the one Who is our Lord, our Savior. "If we are faithless, Christ Jesus remains faithful, for He cannot deny Himself" (2 Timothy 2:13). It is this Truth that can set you free to live as the Child of God He has made you to be. And it's a promise you can take to the world.




whom has devoted the past two years to studying God's Word and learning to listen for His voice. May they continue to seek His guidance and walk boldly in His love. God's Blessings!



Church Council Updates

Discipleship: It was reported that we are registered for Autumn Artistry, cards for visitors have been created and ordered, and ideas for a 4th of July float are being worked on.

Faith Formation: Council approved the purchase of Bibles for the Confirmands.

Resource: The Resource Committee will meet quarterly, but will meet and/or email as needed for financial issues.
